TC Habitat for Humanity


Working to eliminate poverty housing from the Twin Cities and make decent, affordable shelter available for all people.

Undesignated

Undesignated endowments provide The Foundation the flexibility to support existing and unnamed missions that may arise in the future.

Additional Endowment Missions may be created with a minimum \$10,000 gift and the approval of The Foundation board.

Ways to Give

Give while you're living to see your gift at work in addition to leaving a legacy.

- Give to The Foundation through your Will or Trust
- Name The Foundation of St. Andrew's Lutheran Church as the beneficiary or partial beneficiary of your retirement plan, life insurance policy, annuity or other financial instruments
- Create a Charitable Gift Annuity or Charitable Remainder Trust
- Donating appreciated assets may provide significant tax value to you while funding your missional interests
- Leverage the tax benefits of making direct charitable gifts with your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) from your tax deferred retirement accounts OR through a Donor Advised Fund (DAF)

Gifts to a non-profit are normally tax deductible though donors should always seek advice from their attorney, tax or financial professional to ensure their legacy intentions will be properly met.
